Implementation of change appears to have actually increased the rate of late submissions in the spring semester; however, late submissions were concentrated in the first week following the deadline and were thought to be due to a learning curve associated with the new system. Going forward, this problem will be addressed by additional training. Meanwhile, the number of submissions which needed to be returned for revision decreased materially, suggesting that the new system results in more accurate submissions of text requisitions.
